

NYSCA FY2019 CAPITAL FUNDING OPPORTUNITY **COMPARISON**

What are the goals of the program?

Mid-Size Capital Fund: Promote accessibility, stability, and sustainability for communities and support artistic efforts through capital funding.

Large Capital Fund: Strengthen tourism, promote business development, and improve the quality, efficiency and accessibility of New York State arts and cultural organizations through targeted capital investments.

What grant amounts are available?

Mid-Size Capital Fund: \$50,000 - \$250,000

Large Capital Fund: \$250,000 - \$1,000,000

What kinds of projects are eligible?

Mid-Size Capital Fund: Categories include Capital Equipment, such as theatrical lighting and sound systems, sprung flooring, projectors, and museum collections storage systems; Capital Projects, supporting renovation, expansion, or restoration projects including installation of elevators, wheelchair lifts, boilers, and HVAC systems; and Design Studies.

Large Capital Fund: Renovations and/or expansions of space(s) that are open to the public; modifications to provide for sustainable, energy efficient spaces that would result in overall cost savings; accessibility renovations; as well as technology and other equipment that would benefit the public.

Is there a match requirement?

Mid-Size Capital Fund: For most grants, an **actual cash match of 50% of the Total Project Cost is required.** In-kind matches and/or staff time is not eligible for the match requirement. Additionally, funds from any other state agency are ineligible to be used for the match.

Within the mid-size capital fund pool, up to 10 grants of a maximum of \$50,000 each will be available for award with no matching requirement. Organizations must specify at the time of application whether they would like to be considered for one of these grants.

Large Capital Fund: Yes. **An actual cash match of 50% of the Total Project Cost is required.** In-kind matches and/or staff time is not eligible for the match requirement. Additionally, funds from any other state agency are ineligible to be used for the match.

How do I apply?

Mid-Size Capital Fund: Apply through the Consolidated Funding Application for evaluation by NYSCA.

Large Capital Fund: Apply through the Consolidated Funding Application to be evaluated by NYSCA and your local REDC.
